

Arc Northland's Housing Access Services Program (HAS)

To be eligible for HAS **both** the individual and the property where they are
Moving must be eligible.

The individual must be planning to move or in the process of moving.

What HAS can do:

- Provide financial assistance during the moving process
- Pay application fees
- Help pay deposits
- Help pay moving expenses
- Help purchase furnishings, bed and household goods
- Assist with the searching process
- Assist with filling out applications
- Develop budgets
- Meet with landlords/staff and accompany to house showings

What HAS cannot do:

- Financially assist people moving into non-eligible properties. Non-eligible properties are those with services or those with a large number of people with disabilities in them. Examples of non-eligible properties are: Gateway, Lennox, Pennel Park, Esmond/Seaway, Lincoln Park School Apts, HRA locations except Harbor Highlands and scattered sites, Accessible Space Inc., Assisted living...
- Crisis response
- Assist with first or last month's rent
- Make any sort of back payments
- Pay court fees
- Provide furnishings/beds/household goods if not part of the moving process
