

# Arc Northland's Housing Access Services Program (HAS)

To be eligible for HAS the individual **MUST** be actively using or seeking out an ARMHS worker, Semi-Independent Living Skills worker, Private Duty Nursing, or have PCA/PCA Choice.

Individuals on Elderly Waivers and Alternative Care Waivers also qualify. The individual must be planning to move or in the process of moving.

## What HAS can do:

- Pay the individual's application fee
- Help pay deposits, movers, or furniture up to \$500
- Help organize and navigate the moving process
- Assist with the searching process
- Assist with filling out applications
- Talk with landlords/staff and accompany to house showings
- Help develop budgets
- Help provide resources
- Serve Carlton, St. Louis, Lake, and Cook Counties

## What HAS cannot do:

- Crisis response
- Assist with rent
- Make any sort of back payments
- Financially assist if it is NOT part of the moving process
- Pay for movers if items are going anywhere but the individuals new apartment or house that they have signed a lease at
- Provide transportation to clients
- Pay court fee's
- Financially assist with moves into provider controlled housing (example Tri-Towers, some Accessible Space properties, nursing homes, group homes, hospitals, assisted livings, etc.)
